I. PROPOSED MOBILITY PROGRAMME

Language of training: **German**

Overall objectives of the mobility:

- Deepening the cooperation and exchange of theoretical and practical knowledge between Weihenstephan-Triesdorf University of Applied Sciences (HSWT) and University of Sarajevo (UNSA)
- Discuss joint and individual projects in detail to define further cooperation potentials
- Acquiring new and upgrade current knowledge through experiences and good practices at HSWT department of Landscape Architecture and gain practical skills relevant for job and professional development
- Gain knowledge and experience from EU developed countries in this field of education and practice of Designing processes of Open spaces and designed areas

Added value of the mobility (in the context of the modernisation and internationalisation strategies of the institutions involved):

- Deepening knowledge and understanding of principles of planned and designed Open spaces (practical phase: exploring examples in Freising, Ingolstadt, Munich and the surrounding area), thereby obtaining detailed insight and direct experience in this field which helps staff and students at UNSA to develop strategies for implementing new ideas with regards to Urban green infrastructure
- At the Department of Sylviculture and Urban greenery at UNSA several modules in this field are taught, where the obtained knowledge is required, can be applied and will benefit UNSA students; students benefit from examples from abroad and are motivated to participate in international projects and exchange opportunities with HSWT

Activities to be carried out:

- Visit project locations in Freising and LGS-Landesgartenschau (State Horticultural Show) Ingolstadt, where HSWT is an active participant with it's own exhibition area
- Participate in/observe a practical workshop (dry wall construction) at LGS
- Evaluate previous joint projects and prepare final documentation material for publications on those projects (Pula-project)
- Sit in on final presentations of Master Students; observe evaluation and didactical methods at HSWT
- In detail discussion of ongoing and planned research and project activities of the participant to define areas where HSWT can provide input and assistance
- Visiting of several sites in Munich and the surrounding area for research on case studies in Urban green areas

Expected outcomes and impact (e.g. on the professional development of the staff member and on both institutions):

- Gaining knowledge and practice in Landscape architecture planning design methods and skills for teaching and presenting methods in Landscape architecture planning and research methods; as well insight, knowledge and practice on Landscape architecture, Landscape planning, Urban green infrastructure
- Applying new approaches in landscape design methods and skills
- Implementation of the gained knowledge, skills and practice in participants work field, including support of students in Landscape planning, Urban greenery, Garden design etc.
- Using the acquired knowledge for new designing projects and research in the field of Landscape design and planning of urban green infrastructure.



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II. COMMITMENT OF THE THREE PARTIES

By signing⁶ this document, the staff member, the sending institution and the receiving institution confirm that they approve the proposed mobility agreement.

The sending higher education institution supports the staff mobility as part of its modernisation and internationalisation strategy and will recognise it as a component in any evaluation or assessment of the staff member.

The staff member will share his/her experience, in particular its impact on his/her professional development and on the sending higher education institution, as a source of inspiration to others.

The staff member and the beneficiary institution commit to the requirements set out in the grant agreement signed between them.

The staff member and the receiving institution will communicate to the sending institution/enterprise any problems or changes regarding the proposed mobility programme or mobility period.

After completing the mobility the staff member is required to present a certificate of attendance, signed by the receiving institution on the last day of the mobility.

The staff member shall have adequate insurance cover (health insurance and liability insurance). As the Erasmus+ programme does not include any form of insurance, health insurance, personal liability and accident insurance will be taken out for participants by the receiving institution. The cost of this insurance will be borne by participants themselves. This cost will be deducted from the grant amount before it is paid out to participants.
